'We Are The People' is a research team, based at Bath Spa University. Our team consists of disabled people and allies, and we conduct research in South West England.

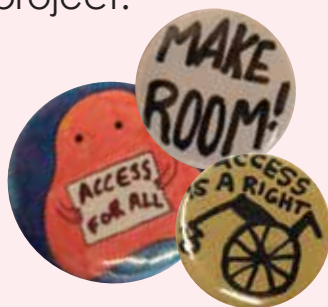
About Make Room!

Event organising top tips to improve accessibility for disabled LGBTQIA+ communities

1

Be transparent about how accessible your event is, in advance, so people can make a choice about attending.



2

Use clear and simple language during the event and provide accessible written information, including Easy Read formats.



3

Provide masks, hand gel and other safer provisions for COVID-19 protection.



4

Have a host to meet anyone attending alone.



5

Create quiet spaces and consider people's sensory needs.



6

Make sure there is enough seating for everybody.



7

Ensure all venue staff have completed 'equality, diversity and inclusion' training.
